GASFITTING REGISTRATION

Only persons holding subsisting certificates of registration in respect of gasfitting issued by the Plumbers and Gasfitters Registration Board under the Plumbers and Gasfitters Registration Act 1951 may undertake gasfitting work (installation, alteration or repair – LP gas systems as defined) in Tasmania.

Currently the pre-requisites for registration in respect of gasfitting are as follows –

An applicant is required to satisfy the Board that he –

- (a) has completed an apprenticeship in sanitary or mechanical services plumbing or gasfitting, or has had at least five (5) years' experience in gasfitting and or relevant plumbing work (sanitary, mechanical services or water plumbing); and
- (b) during the period of overall trade experience has performed gasfitting work under supervision (viz installed or assisted in installing residential gas appliances or in installing and maintaining commercial or industrial gas systems or assisting in such work) acceptable to the Board as indicating specific gasfitting trade experience; and
- (c) holds a prescribed qualification.

The current registration fee is **\$53.20** (but if combined with any other registration class the higher fee is applicable only).

The prescribed qualifications are either –

- (i) in respect of persons eligible for sanitary, mechanical services or water plumbing registration (Journeyman or Advanced) – a pass in the examinations for the subjects Gasfitting Theory and Gasfitting Procedures conducted by the Education Department or the Board;
- (ii) in respect of other persons (without sanitary, mechanical services or water plumbing qualifications) – a pass in the examinations listed in (i) plus a pass in the subject Gasfitting Practice (i.e. fabrication) conducted by the Board or the Department; or
- (iii) a qualification in gasfitting as prescribed in the ANZRA Agreement (i.e. gained in certain other States or countries)

When applying for registration in respect of gasfitting, applicants should complete a Trade Experience Declaration or submit other evidence (e.g. employer's statement) of their gasfitting trade experience.
