## INFORMATION SEMINARS

It's that time again...updates to the Building Code of Australia (BCA) for 2008 are being developed, and as building industry practitioners you need to know what changes are coming into effect. The Australian Building Codes Board (ABCBC) in conjunction with its Seminar partner, the Australian Institute of Refrigeration, Air Conditioning and Heating (AIRAH) is hosting a series of Information Seminars in capital cities around Australia to inform you of these changes.

The half-day seminars will involve an overview of significant changes to feature in BCA 2008, hosted by the ABCBC. This will be followed by a presentation by AIRAH to refresh practitioners on parts of Section J including:

- Part J5 – Air Conditioning and Ventilation – DTS Provisions for new buildings
- Part J6 – Artificial Lighting and Power – DTS Provisions for new buildings
  - Verification Methods for New Buildings
