

# Occupational Licensing (Standards of Plumbing Work) Code of Practice 2010

## *Occupational Licensing Act 2005*

15 December 2010

I, Kerrie Davidia Crowder, Administrator of Occupational Licensing, appointed under section 10 of the *Occupational Licensing Act 2005* (“the Act”), in accordance with section 53 of the Act, establish the following Code of Practice.

### 1. **Short title**

This Code of Practice may be cited as the *Occupational Licensing (Standards of Plumbing Work) Code of Practice 2010*.

### 2. **Commencement**

This Code of Practice takes effect on 15 December 2010.

### 3. **Purpose**

This code sets the minimum standards for plumbing work.

### 4. **Application of Acts Interpretation Act 1931**

The *Acts Interpretation Act 1931* applies to this Code of Practice.

### 5. **Interpretation**

In this code of practice, unless the context otherwise requires –

“**plumbing work**” has a definition prescribed by regulation 3 of the *Occupational Licensing (Plumbing Work) Regulations 2010*;

“**Tasmanian Plumbing Code**” means the code issued by the Minister for Workplace Relations under section 58 of the *Building Act 2000*, to provide for requirements in respect of –

- (a) plumbing work, plumbing installations and plumbing products; and
- (b) the testing of plumbing products and plumbing systems;

### 6. **Standards of Plumbing Work**

The Tasmanian Plumbing Code is incorporated into this Code.

### 7. **Persons must comply with this Code**

A person performing plumbing work must comply with the Tasmanian Plumbing Code.
