



Visual Clearance Certificate (Asbestos Removal) (AR4)

Notes: A competent & independent person (refer to Workplace Standards Tasmania's guide to interpretation of requirements for definition) must conduct a visual inspection of the removal area following completion of the removal work and issue a clearance certificate prior to re-occupancy by unprotected workers.

A clearance inspection can only be conducted after all ACM has been removed, wrapped & stored in a collection container and all asbestos fragments and dusts have been collected and sealed in the same manner. **Barriers and signage must remain in place until the competent person issues a visual clearance certificate.**
