BCA 2007 INFORMATION SEMINARS

Purpose

This *News Update* is to inform building practitioners, councils, permit authorities, and building owners of information seminars on changes made by the Building Code of Australia 2007.

Background

Updates to the Building Code of Australia (BCA) for 2007 are being developed, and as building industry practitioners you need to know what changes are coming into effect. The Australian Building Codes Board (ABCB) is hosting a series of Information Seminars in capital cities around Australia to inform you of these changes.

An information seminar will be held in Hobart on 20 March 2007 at the Grand Chancellor Hotel, 1 Davey Street.

The half-day seminar will be divided into an overview of the changes to feature in the BCA 2007, hosted by the ABCB, followed by an update on changes to related Australian standards, presented by Standards Australia.

The objective of the seminar is to help promote awareness of the changes and present you with the facts and know-how to successfully apply the BCA.

If you are involved in designing, assessing or constructing buildings you need to know how these provisions will affect the way you work. The seminar will provide you with an opportunity to learn the issues from technical experts.
